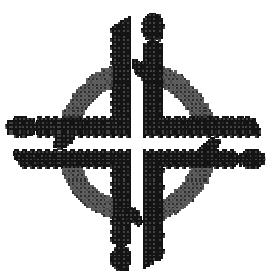
## Eldership Seminar
